

For PR Agency, the Combination of NETGEAR® ReadyNAS® and Egnyte® Local Cloud on NAS Performs Like a Rock Star

Background

With a small core staff and a roster of freelancers and contractors who work on projects, A Star PR is a typical small company, with no IT staff to support the agency's systems. The agency had been using a hosted Microsoft Exchange Server to store its Word and Excel files, in addition to images and video it required for various promotional campaigns. However, the solution was becoming increasingly slow and inefficient. With a reliance on a remote management company to keep the system running, it was also quite expensive. In response, the agency shifted to Google Apps six months ago, to increase productivity, while lowering costs.

While the new solution worked well for the agency, it also created a need for a more robust file storage and sharing solution – one that would enable remote access of critical files, secure check-in and check-out of shared documents, version control, and protection against data loss. The solution would need to be secure, robust, and cost-effective. It would also have to support the agency's computing environment, which is a blend of Macs and PCs.

Like most small businesses without an IT staff, one of A Star PR's employees would need to become the unofficial IT department, in addition to his "day job". Sam Taylor, one of the agency's PR Consultants, was volunteered for the task. Sam's primary objective was clear from the start: to find a solution that makes it easy for everybody to access the files they need, whether they are physically in the office, or working remotely. "Just about everybody in our office works from home at times, plus we have a couple of contractors who are exclusively remote," says Sam.
